General Information:

During this period, a Mycology section and laboratory were established to study the mycotic diseases of Thailand. The objectives of these studies will be to gather information on the prevalence and distribution of all mycoses of importance in this area of the world. Little information is currently available, therefore collection of data to permit evaluation of each of the potentially important mycoses is essential. In addition to the cosmopolitan dermatophytes, which can be a major cause of morbidity, studies will initially concentrate on those mycoses that are most likely to be found in Thailand.
