General Information

The study report on anthrax originally was designed to provide information pertinent to the incidence of this disease. It has been demonstrated that the organism is widely distributed and is a significant public health hazard. Further investigation is not contemplated, therefore the study report pertaining to anthrax is submitted as a final report.

Because of the proximity of Thailand to other countries in which plague is occurring, a surveillance program has been initiated.
